Perfect for leaders, organizers, and decision-makers in churches and faith-based nonprofits

This training explores the Biblical basis for adopting a relational ministry focus and provides a detailed framework for developing that culture in your organization. It will help you think differently about your serving model, develop partnerships with other ministries, and create a strategy for engaging your community. You'll also learn about the importance of training your volunteers to share the gift of ongoing presence ("walking with others").

In this workshop, attendees gain concrete strategies for shifting the way they serve others while growing in their confidence to share Christ in a relational way.

Learning to collaborate for greater Kingdom impact

Perfect for any ministry leaders and volunteers from both churches and Christian nonprofits

This training is designed to understand partnerships from both sides and how to develop a common Kingdom goal. It prioritizes making disciples while also serving those with needs, including your neighbors.

Option 1: The Power of "With"

- Interactive workshop (3-5 hours; customized for the organization)
- Comprehensive workbooks: The Power of "With" (78 pages; one per participant)
- Connection Q&A (a virtual, follow-up "town hall" that allows participants to ask questions, share experiences, and describe challenges after having an opportunity to apply the training principles)

Fee for organizations outside of Austin:

Fee for organizations in the Greater Austin area: \$30/per person; includes workbooks and materials \$300 (\$600 overnight) plus \$30/per person; includes workbooks materials. Coverage of travel expenses as needed.

This workshop can be designed for up to five hours, offered over multiple sessions, or included as part of a group retreat. Extended hours negotiable.

- Interactive workshop (2 hours; customized for the organization)
- Comprehensive workbooks: Walking with Others (30 pages; one per participant)
- Connection Q&A (a virtual, follow-up "town hall" that allows participants to ask questions, share experiences, and describe challenges after having an opportunity to apply the training principles)

Fee for organizations outside of Austin:

Fee for organizations in the Greater Austin area: \$20/per person; includes workbooks and materials \$300 (\$600 overnight) plus \$20/per person; includes workbooks and materials. Coverage of travel expenses as needed.

Option 3: Church/Nonprofit Partnership

Initial strategy consultation, interactive workshop (2-3 hours), and connection Q&A

Fee for organizations in the Greater Austin area: \$10/per person (\$200 minimum)

Fee for organizations outside of Austin:

\$300 (\$600 overnight) plus \$10/per person. Coverage of

travel expenses as needed.
